
Training Tracks Include

1. Practitioner Training

2. Training of Trainers

- ► Everything above plus: the Trainer Manual, powerpoint slides, forms and online resource links.
- Extra hour each day plus two additional days of instruction.
- ► A coach to help you implement the course over the following year.
- Membership to the Academy Trainer's Network, including monthly webinars and online trainer community access.
- Trainers who demonstrate competence as an instructor of the course will achieve Approved Trainer Status after one year.
